# Report on the 21st International Day of the African Child

<u>Theme:</u> "Together for urgent action in favour of street children"

#### INTRODUCTION

Celebrated since 1991, the 16<sup>th</sup> June of each year, the Day of the African Child which commemorates the Soweto matching of young college students of 1976, in South Africa, who went into the streets to express their dissatisfaction for the poor quality of education and who will be riddled with real bullets, are the founders of the Organisation of Africa's Unity (OAU), later replace in 2002 by the African Union (AU). Therefore established to remember the courage of these thousand of students, the Day of the African Child remains a good opportunity for African leaders, Non Governmental Organisations and Civil Society Organisations to dwell on the day to day live of young Africans.

As part of its activities related to childhood, the *Fondation Kana* has associated with the International and African community to celebrate this day on the 16<sup>th</sup> June as it does each year. The theme of this 21<sup>st</sup> edition is "together for urgent action in favour of street children."

#### **SEQUENCE OF THE ACTIVITY**

For this 21st edition, the *Fondation Kana* joined the ROSPYV (private social networks of Yaounde V) and it should be noted that each year a structure registered under ROSPYV receives and co-organises the event. So this year, the CRISPEFP which is a centre in charge of training children in difficulties, situated in Ngousso Ntem Rail sis behind the Chinese hospital. For this event on 15/06/11, FK was more involved because a good part of its team was present especially as its secretary general is also coordinator of the ROSPY V.

On this day, children of the structure were present, as well as orphans and children with hearing impaired supervised by the *Fondation Kana* who are mostly artist.

The program was well respected; the different speakers said a word of welcome, while alluding to the theme of this 21<sup>th</sup> edition of this year which really demanded special consideration and a strong focus for the structures that supervise children.

Following the speaker's words especially that of the coordinator of the *Fondation Kana* who emphasized that investment on a child is not only profitable in a medium term, but also ensures sustainable development and this gives all importance to the theme chosen for this edition. The authority of MINAS borrowed the initiative of the *Fondation Kana* to keep moving forward for the well being of the children it supports and monitors. He equally recalled the tragedy of 16<sup>th</sup> June 1976 in Soweto before indicating that the theme of the Day is synonymous to an invitation to mobilization for more sustained attention to children and devote more resources to them.

There was silence to see the hearing impaired children develop a poem on the situation of children with difficulties, orphans who interpreted some songs to spice up the mood.

Then, an opportunity was given to the children to show their know-how, because many of them already have training with different trades, including: carpenters, painters, tailors and even culinary artists.

During the presentation of children to the open door, we had the opportunity to see that these children, with the support they receive are already likely to be able to cope and that this has to be checked to enable others to come out of the misery of handicapped and OVC (Orphans and Vulnerable Children).

After the open door, a cocktail was jointly offered by the organisation and ROSPY V to invitees and children, followed by a family picture with everyone present.

#### **OBJECTIVE OF THE ACTIVITY**

The objective was:

- ✓ To show the soundness of the structures that supports the children, to plan and budget for the resources we have available to them, to ensure their well being is the goal of the *Fondation Kana*, and ROSPY V and that was seen during the open door that they were subsequently presented.
- ✓ To make known the organisation to the various officials and invitees who were present that day.

#### **SUGGESTION**

As a suggestion, it was noticed that the associations in general and those listed in the ROSPY V taking care of childhood did not perform that day, and this is a gaudy attitude within the Associations.

Also, we need to draw the attention of NGO's and associations on the theme of this 21<sup>th</sup> edition which shows that good budgeting and planning followed by a good responsibility can help the well-being of the latter which is tomorrow's citizens.

#### FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY

Financially, this 21st edition of the Day of the African Child asked for a strong mobilisation of children who supervise orphans and handicaps, because they are in different structures in Yaounde and had to ensure movement + nutrition for the day.
